Tanzania's charismatic Gogo innovator Msafiri Zawose breaks open the circle of tradition, the flock of songs and tunes, beats and melodies his fellow musicians have relied on for generations. **Jubilant voices** dance over a broad palette of timbres like the buzzy bowed zeze. **Swaying polyrhythms** combine in **tranced-out jams**, only to shift into delicate filigree of malimba (thumb piano) and vocal counterpoint. It speaks to Msafiri's simultaneous **deep engagement** with and **playful reframing of tradition**.

#### BIOGRAPHY

A charismatic performer, prolific songwriter and multi-instrumentalist. Msafiri Zawose is one of the most admired Gogo musicians today. Beginning his career at the tender age of twelve, the importance of the traditions of this music in Tanzanian culture was instilled in him by his father, musical icon Dr. Hukwe Zawose, which has lead him to strive to preserve Gogo music.

However, Msafiri's fusion of traditional Gogo instrumentation and modern rhythms, coupled with his transcendent vocals, has created a unique, soulful and spiritual sound. In this way, he continues to honor his father's legacy whilst cementing his position as a musical pioneer in Tanzania and the world at large. Additionally, he has not only managed to remain relevant amongst local fans, but has succeeded in attracting an international audience through his numerous tours and workshops across the globe.

Msafiri continues to be an inspiration to Tanzanian and other African musicians alike.



They turn once cyclical pieces into choruses, bridges, and intriguing moments of arresting, tight harmonies. Layers build, repeating elements overlap and turn to grooves."
